1899 - His mother, Elizabeth Ethel (Gaskin), dies aged 25Y, James is 4Y.

1899 to 1903 - His father enters a relationship with Helene Gaskin. He would have been aged between 4-8 years.

1917 - June 15th, Cousin Victor Little, son of Metha, Killed In Action, Belgium.

1917 - WW1, Nov 21st, aged 18Y, Embarkation, arrived 7th January 1918 to Liverpool, Merseyside.
