

Previously Reported Missing, Death Now Presumed McGLINCHY, Stoker Thomas, Christchurch.



STOKER THOMAS McGLINCHY, son of Ir and Mrs P. McGlinchy, 126, Canon Street, St Albans, previously reported mising, now officially presumed dead. Stoker McGlinchy was serving on H.M.S. Electric, which was sunk near Singapore in February, 1941.
