The local Postmaster must be notified promptly of any permanent change of address and the licence forwarded for amendment.

It is an offence under the Radio Regulations to commit to writing for the purpose of publication in a newspaper, without the authority of the Minister of Telegraphs, information received from a broadcasting station, or to make use of or to divulge to any unauthorised person information received from any other class of radio station.
