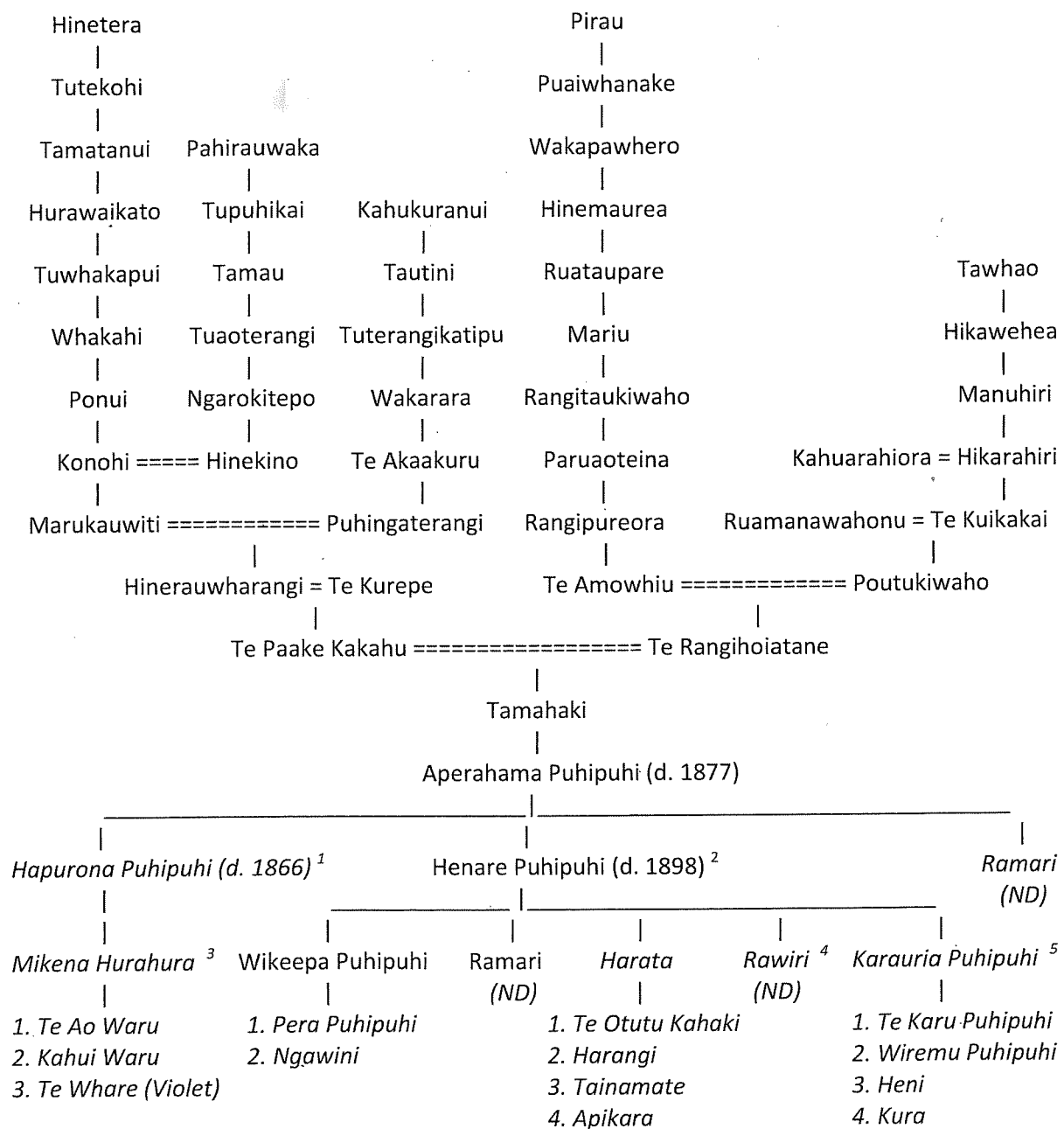


--: Manuscript Tree --:



Description:

To get an initial grip of the whakapapa in this transcription the Tree down to Aperahama provides a summarised visual overview of *some* major branches of the whakapapa recovered; such as **Konohi**. As an update of the Tree - all *known* descendants to the 3rd generation down from Aperahama have been included. Today, for Puhipuhi whanau descendants this manuscript tree and the transcription therefore provide an important historic legacy of tremendous value.

¹ Hapurona is also known by the pseudonym: Hoepoaka. He is a missing line not found in the damaged material.

² Henare had other children who died without issue.

³ Mikena Hurahura is more commonly known as Teia Waipuke.

⁴ Rawiri is also known as Te Raroa.

⁵ Karauria is also known as Te Aruhe. His wife Hera Patene (Taki) is mentioned in the manuscript in her own right.
