Attested and marched into Trentham Camp: 1 May 1915

Rank: Private

Unit: Canterbury Infantry Battalion

Embarked from Wellington New Zealand on His Majesty's New Zealand Troop Ship Number 25  
SS Tahiti: 12 June 1915

Disembarked Suez: 1 August 1915

Joined Battalion in Dardanelles (Gallipoli) 9 August 1915

Severely wounded in knee by shrapnel, admitted to Hospital Ship then Stationary Hospital Port  
Said: 24 August 1915

Discharged from Hospital for light duties: 9 October 1915

Embarked on SS Marquette at Alexandria for Salonica: 19 October 1915

Arrived Salonica: 30 October 1915

Admitted to Hospital: 25 December 1915

Discharged to Duty: 10 January 1916

Attached to No 1 Stationary Hospital: 25 March 1916

Classified permanent "B" (Medical fitness grade) 1 May 1916 transferred to the New Zealand  
Medical Corps from that date.

Embarked on HMS Dover Castle at Alexandria: 2 June 1916

Disembarked at Havre (France) 13 June 1916

Temporarily detached to No 53 Casualty Clearing Station: 2 August 1917

Rejoined New Zealand Stationary Hospital in the field: 8 September 1917

With NZOA France: 29 January 1918

To United Kingdom on leave: 23 August 1918

Rejoined Unit: 8 September 1918

Appointed Lance Corporal: 22 September 1918

Detached to United Kingdom on duty: 26 December 1918

Marched into Walton from New Zealand Stationary Hospital: 28 December 1918

Taken on strength of Hospital Ship Maheno at Avonmouth (UK) 10 March 1919

Embarked for New Zealand on His Majesty's New Zealand Troop Ship Number: 231 SS Maheno from Avonmouth: 10 March 1919

Disembarked at Wellington: 21 April 1919

Taken off strength and posted to leave: 24 April 1919

Discharged: 24 May 1919
