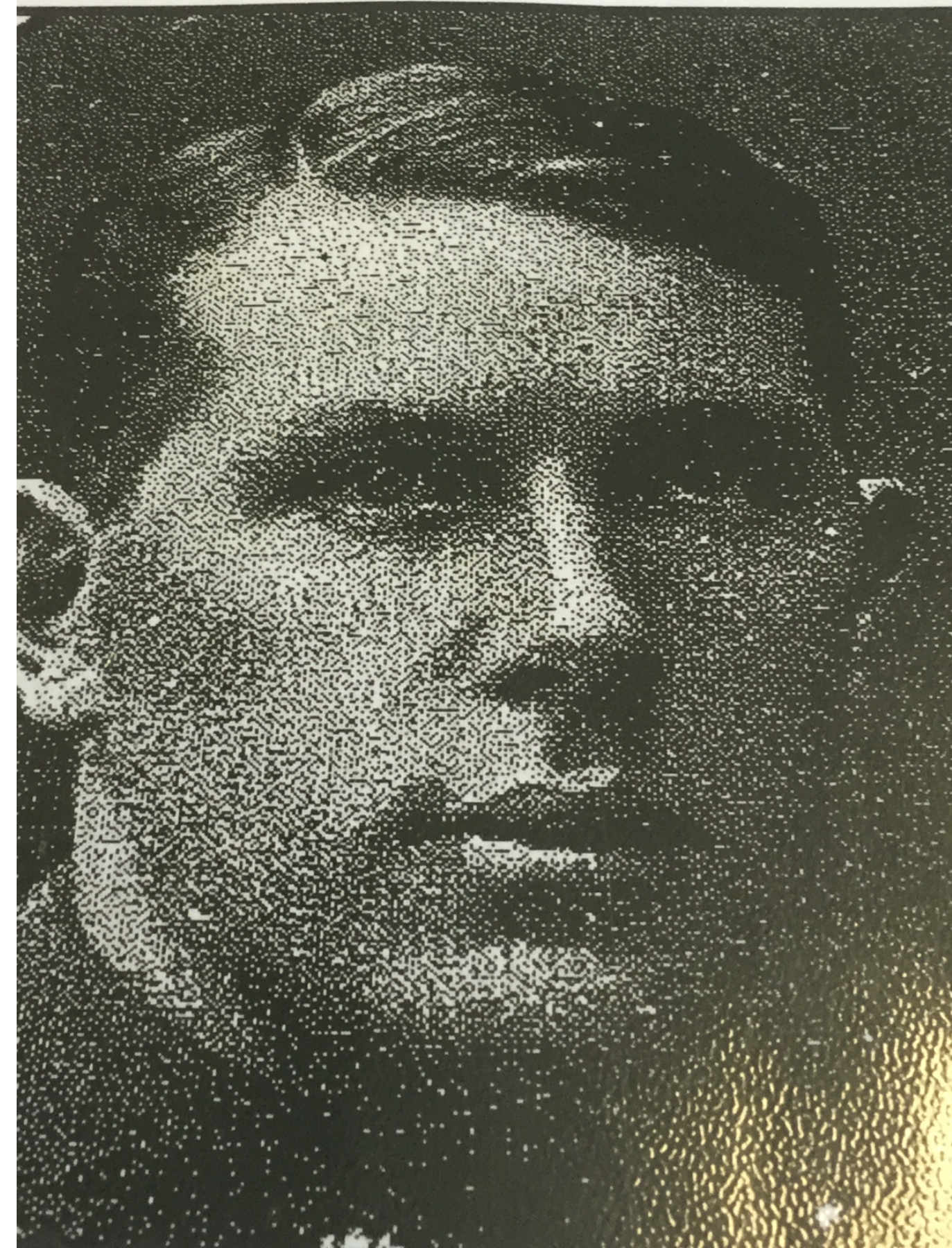

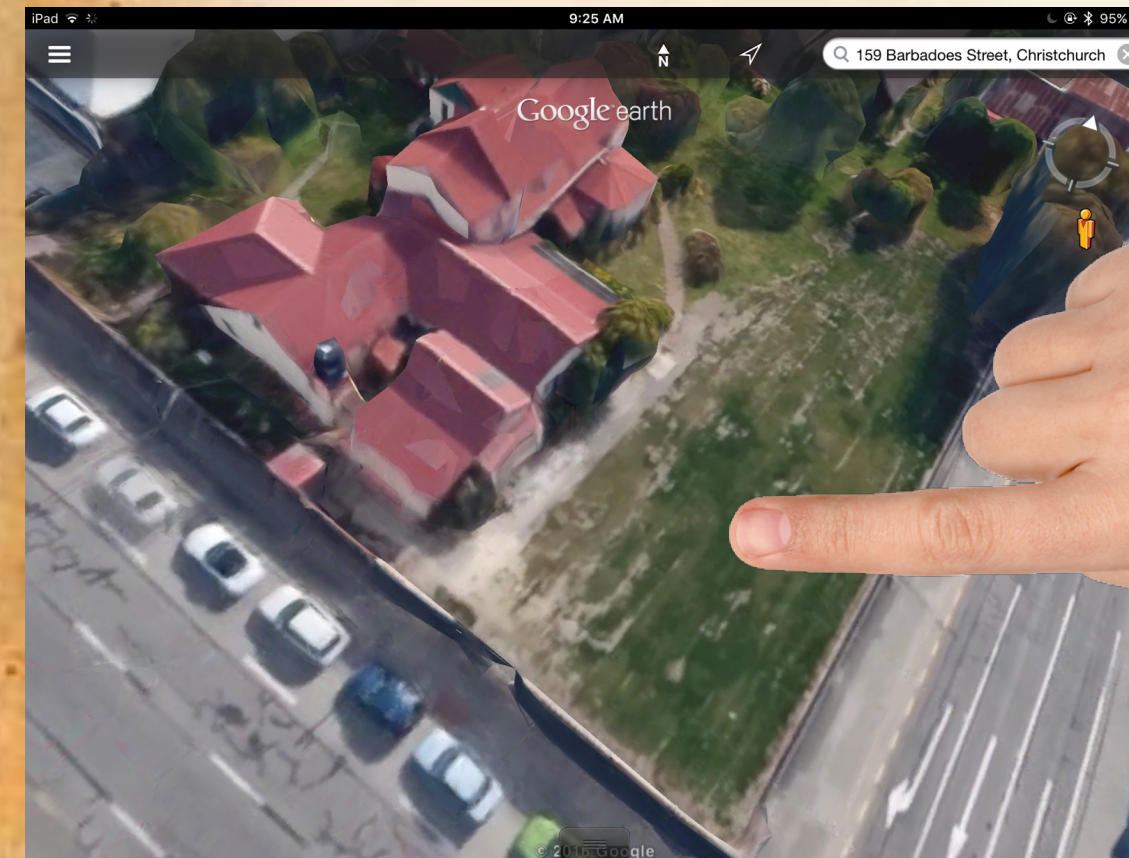

Personal background

Hugh was born in 1897. His parents were Thomas Cahill and Catherine Angelo . He was born in Hokitika and his parents moved to 159 Barbadoes Street Christchurch. Cahill loved to play cricket and hand ball that's why later in his life he joined in with the Sacred Heart teams . His job after leaving Sacred Heart College was as an accountant

Hugh Cahill was one of the first boys to enter the college from the South Island. He was at SHC for 3 years between 1910 and 1913. Hugh enjoyed playing most of the sports that were provided by the college, being in the First 15 and the First 11 but he enjoyed cricket and handball more than anything else. Hugh Cahill loved those two sports so much that he entered the finals for handball and was always accepted for the cricket season. He became a Vice President of the Children of Mary in his final year, and in 1912 he joined the cadet corps. In December 1914, Hugh left the college to become an accountant in Christchurch.

Enlistment in the Army

Hugh enlisted for the New Zealand Expeditionary force and was trained in Wellington. Hugh sadly never fought in France, because on the route to the Somme he died of influenza that had spread through out the ship he was on.
