

Wing Commander Bryan Ronald FRANCIS joined the Royal New Zealand Air Force (RNZAF) on 10 January 1967 as a Navigator Under Training. He graduated as the top Navigator on his course, and was awarded the Astrolabe Trophy for his excellence in training.

Following graduation, Wing Commander FRANCIS was posted to No 4 Operational Orientation Course, from which he proceeded to No 3 Battlefield Support Squadron, to become a Navigator on Bristol Freighter aircraft. In 1969 he was posted to No 41 Squadron based at Changi, Singapore. He qualified for the Vietnam Service Medal during this two year tour.

Subsequently, Wing Commander FRANCIS served on No 40 Squadron navigating C130 aircraft. He became a Qualified Navigator Instructor in 1973 before returning to No 40 Squadron and eventually to No 1 Squadron, flying Andover aircraft. Wing Commander FRANCIS achieved an 'A' category as a navigator - the ultimate qualification standard for an RNZAF Navigator.

Throughout his twenty six years service Wing Commander FRANCIS has epitomised the quiet, intensely loyal officer who has made his mark by his thoroughly professional approach to whatever task was set him. In spinal appointment as Commanding Officer Administrative Wing he has had wide ranging responsibilities of both command and management. His success in this position is a fair testament to the talents of Wing commander FRANCIS.
