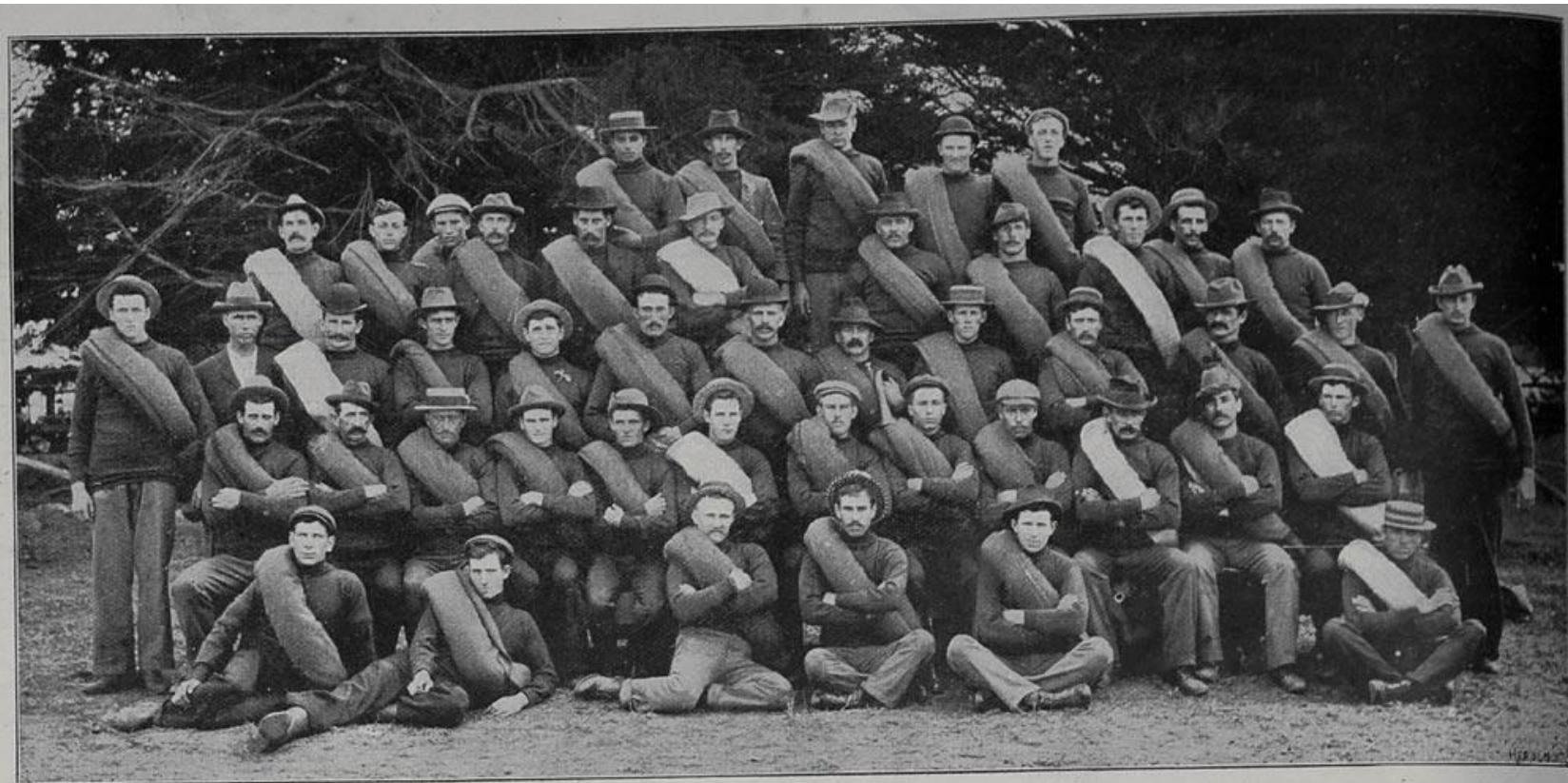

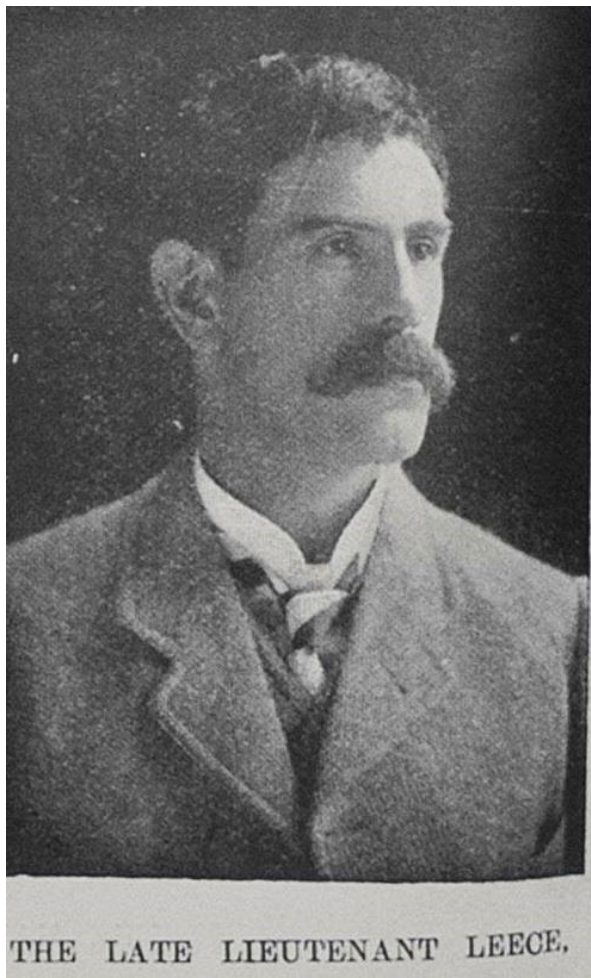

SECTION OF THE AUCKLAND FIFTH CONTINGENT WHICH LEFT BY THE MAPOURIKA.



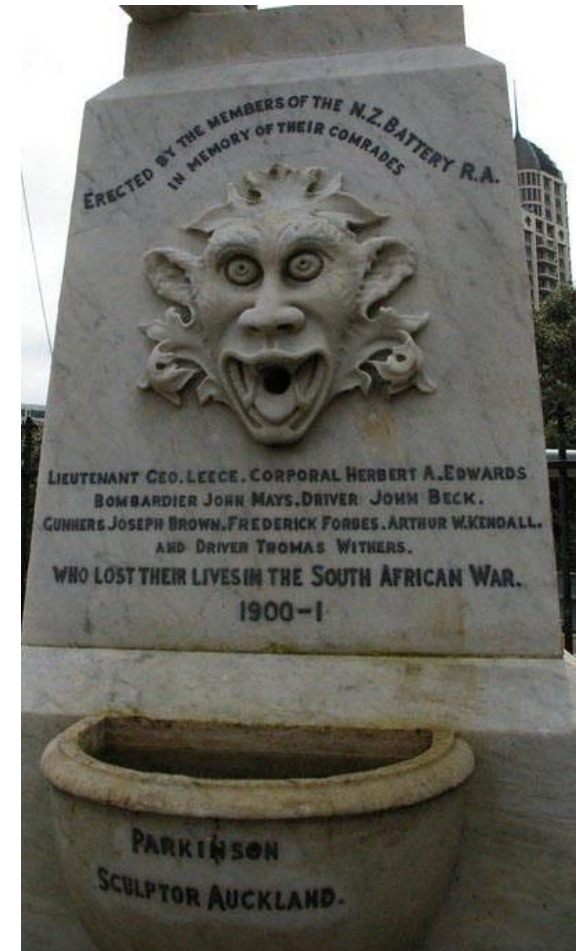
